Remark

1. Entrepreneurs seeking international Halal certification must first be certified by the Central Islamic Council of Thailand (CICOT).
2. For certification extensions or follow-up audits (in cases of non-compliance), a fee of 50% of the original rate shall be applied.
3. For surveillance audits, a fee of 70% of the original rate shall be applied.
4. If certification is requested for more than one standard, fees will be charged for each standard in accordance with the aforementioned fee schedule.
5. The audit for each standard must be conducted separately, with man-days allocated according to the specific requirements of each standard.
6. The aforementioned fees cover Halal certification for UAE, SFDA, HAK, Indonesia, and other standards for which CICOT is a member.
7. Certification fees will be collected based on the validity period of the respective standard (e.g., 3 years), with payments made on an annual basis. Certification and product listing fees shall comply with the 2016 Regulation on Product Audit and Fees, adjusted according to the number of years certified under the requested standard.
8. Additional fees may be charged if the specific national standard requires a technical expert or a specialized auditor.
9. The aforementioned fees do not include laboratory analysis costs; all such expenses are the responsibility of the applicant.
